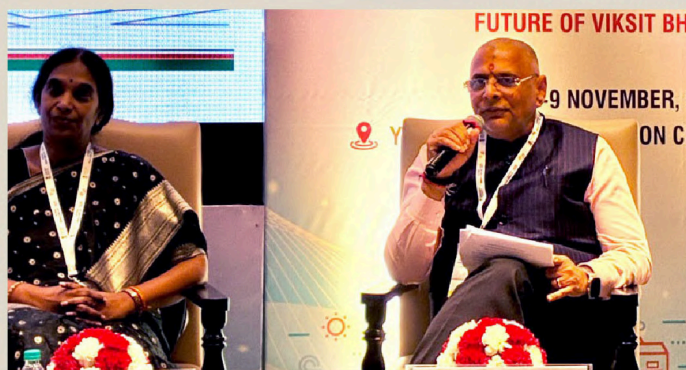


NAREDCO President met Shri Tokhan Sahu, Hon'ble Minister of State, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India

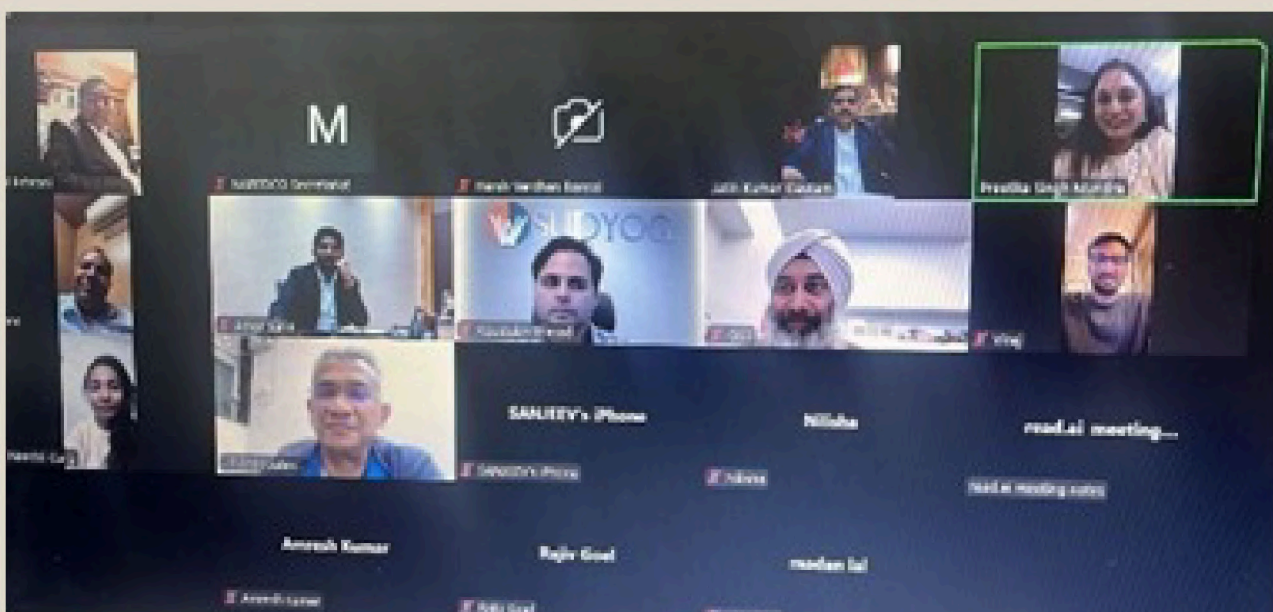

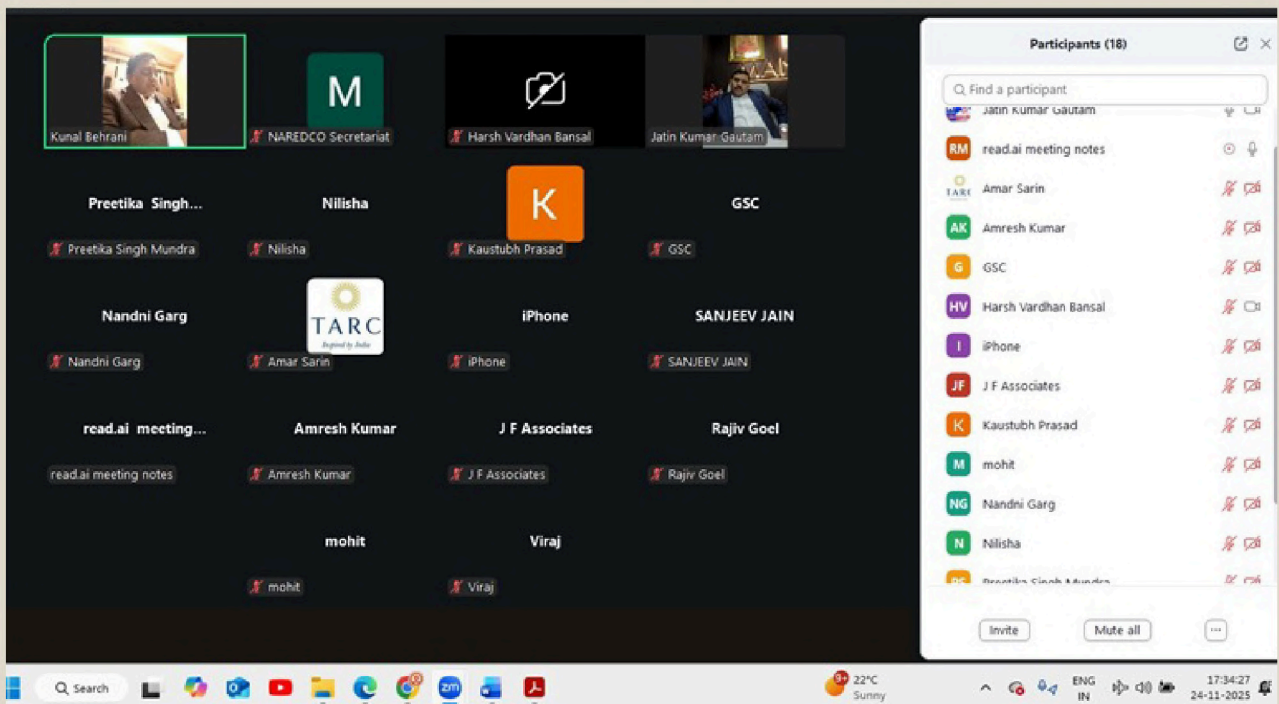
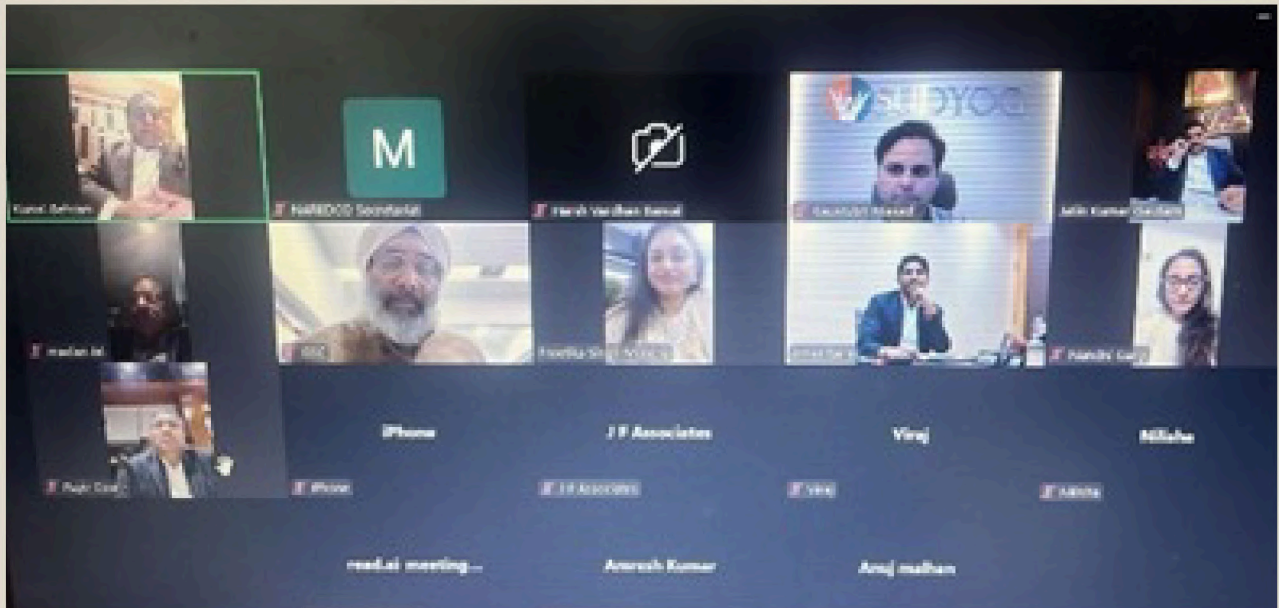


NAREDCO Delhi organised its First Annual General Meeting (AGM)

On 24th November 2025, NAREDCO Delhi successfully organised its First Annual General Meeting (AGM) digitally chaired by President Shri Harsh Vardhan Bansal. The AGM was convened to review the year's progress and discussed the Vision Plan for strengthening Delhi's real estate ecosystem. As part of this plan, the President announced the formation of specialised committees to streamline coordination and ensure focused follow-up on important policy areas. These committees include CAQM, TOD/TDR, MCD/DJB Coordination, Delhi Master Plan, Minimum Wages in Delhi, and issues to be taken up with the Central Government. Each sub-committee will comprise 2–3 members who will work collaboratively to address sector-specific concerns. During the meeting, Shri Kunal Behrani was also appointed as the Honorary Secretary in recognition of his proactive coordination efforts on behalf of NAREDCO Delhi.

The AGM also featured an extensive discussion on real estate challenges and opportunities in Delhi. Members highlighted the urgent need to revitalise Delhi as a leading commercial hub and raised issues such as high land prices, low FAR provisions, and the absence of dedicated Special Commercial Zones or IT Parks. They also emphasised the importance of redeveloping old commercial and industrial plots, expediting slum redevelopment, addressing UEI concerns, easing the conversion of leasehold to freehold plots, and rationalising high amalgamation charges. Persistent challenges with securing NOCs, layout approvals under MCD, applicability of Green Building Policy and GBF, delays in TDR/TOD implementation, and bottlenecks in the Land Pooling Policy were also discussed.





Shri Kunal Behrani Highlighted Sustainable Construction Practices at a workshop on “Building for Heat Resilience”

On 12th November 2025, Shri Kunal Behrani, Honorary Secretary, NAREDCO Delhi & Chief Operating Officer, Unity Group participated as a panelist at the workshop on “Building for Heat Resilience” organized by the Decarbonization Business Charter, UNEP (United Nations Environment Programme), and NAREDCO Mahi. As the Honorary Secretary of NAREDCO Delhi, he took part in the focused group discussion on Low-Carbon Materials, where the panel explored key issues shaping the future of sustainable and climate-resilient construction.

A significant part of the discussion focused on the quality and specifications of chemicals and cement used at construction sites, particularly the distinctions between OPC (Ordinary Portland Cement) and CPC (Composite Portland Cement). The panel emphasized the importance of educating all stakeholders about various cement types and their environmental impacts. By promoting awareness and encouraging the adoption of low-carbon alternatives such as CPC and other sustainable materials, the industry can make substantial progress in reducing the overall carbon footprint of buildings.

The panel emphasized that developers and industry leaders have a responsibility to drive this change, ensuring that construction practices contribute positively to environmental preservation and long-term sustainability. Through informed choices and collaborative efforts, they can build not just structures, but a better and more sustainable future for the environment.





Shri Kunal Behrani Shared Strategic Perspectives for Real Estate Growth at BIG FM Conclave

Representing NAREDCO Delhi, Shri Kunal Behrani shared insights on policy matters influencing real estate marketing and advertising practices. The panelists discussed critical challenges such as construction delays caused by GRAP and proposed strategic solutions. These included forming dedicated teams for government liaison, enhancing industry representation, and raising awareness about the importance of allotment letters—possibly by adopting powerful branding, similar to the diamond industry’s “Heera, Sada Ke Liye” and mutual fund campaigns.

The dialogue also touched upon the evolving role of AI governance and its potential to revolutionize marketing within the sector. Overall, it was a forward-thinking discussion that highlighted innovation, transparency, and improved governance as key drivers for unlocking growth and strengthening trust in the real estate industry.

Govt eyes realty bankruptcy at tower level to ease misery

The government and the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI) are examining if the proposed framework tailored for real estate sector should attempt to resolve financial distress at the level of individual projects or at the level of individual towers within a project, according to two persons familiar with the discussions.

Identifying the exact scope of a proposed new regulatory regime for rescuing distressed assets in the housing sector is a key area of the consultations that the ministry of corporate affairs (MCA) and IBBI have started after the Supreme Court in September ordered coordinated action by all stakeholders to protect the interests of homebuyers and restore confidence in the real estate sector.

Narrowing bankruptcy resolution to a single project—or even a single tower within a project—raises fresh policy questions for the authorities, including how to treat a developer that has defaulted on repayments.

“Creditor taking over the management of a defaulting company under IBC is a deterrence against financial indiscipline and payment defaults, and it penalises the erring management. If one tower that is facing distress is ring-fenced for resolution without affecting the rest of the assets of the defaulting company, that deterrence gets diluted,” said the first of the two persons cited earlier, both of whom spoke on the condition of anonymity.

Queries emailed to MCA and to IBBI remained unanswered.

At present, insolvency resolution takes place only at the level of the corporate entity. Once a bankruptcy plea is admitted in a tribunal, creditors appoint an insolvency professional to run the company who also invites bids from new investors. All its assets are

developer undisturbed, such an approach may not be aligned with one basic event envisaged under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC)—creditors taking over the affairs of the company in the event of a payment default.

after extensive government deliberations, is likely to be taken up for passage before the current discussions on real estate—specific reforms are finalised.

Niranjan Hiranandani, chairman of real estate industry association NAREDCO said the move to develop a dedicated bankruptcy framework for real estate is a welcome step.

“Our industry runs on project-level cash flows, so resolving insolvency at the project or even tower level can protect homebuyers and keep construction on track,” said Hiranandani.

“A tower-wise approach can help ensure that work on other parts of the project continues without affecting the entire development or the company. What matters is that the system stays fair for all stakeholders and prevents misuse. We need a balanced structure that protects buyers and lenders while allowing genuine developers to finish homes without long delays,” added Hiranandani.

Insolvency resolution at corporate level should remain the last resort, reserved for cases where financial stress is pervasive across the developer’s entire portfolio, said Manmeet Kaur, partner at law firm Karanjawala & Co.

“A project-wise resolution framework offers the most balanced and practical approach as it fences each project’s cash flows and liabilities, safeguards buyers of that specific project, and prevents the insolvency of one project from bringing the entire company/entity to a standstill. That being said, in certain large townships or multi-tower developments where each tower is functionally and financially distinct, a tower-level resolution could offer even greater precision,” said Kaur.

Indian Realty Strong Amid Global Shocks

Developers recalibrate supply and buyers stay active as demand, finance conditions help

Mumbai: India's real estate sector is showing steadiness despite global headwinds, marked by resilient demand, stable financing, and disciplined supply across major cities. Sentiment on the ground has stayed constructive, supported by sustained activity in both premium housing and office leasing. A stable and relatively lower interest-rate environment, along with easing inflation, has further boosted buyer confidence.

The past few quarters have revealed a clear pattern with buyers and occupiers continuing to transact in segments facing demand, while developers have recalibrated launches to

avoid excess supply, particularly in lower-ticket housing, showed a study by property consultancy Knight Frank India and industry body Naredco.

"The sustained optimism underscores the sector's resilience and adaptability, said Shishir Bajjal, CMD, Knight Frank India. "Both current and future sentiment scores remain comfortably in the positive zone, reaffirming confidence in India's economic stability and long-term growth story."

He said demand in the premium residential segment remains healthy, while the office market is continuing to show structural depth with strong leasing pipelines. The current sentiment score has improved to 59 from 56 last quarter, the highest reading recorded this year. The future sentiment score stayed unchanged at 61, indicating that stakeholders expect the momentum to hold in the coming

months, showed the report. Among key markets, south India remained the most optimistic driven by strong office activity in Bengaluru and Hyderabad alongside demand for high-ticket homes.

"Developers and investors remain optimistic, supported by stable demand, policy continuity, and healthy funding conditions," said Parveen Jain, president, Naredco. "Premium housing and office spaces are driving growth, signalling a balanced, resilient outlook for the sector in the coming months."

Among markets, north India showed improvement, backed by steady leasing in Delhi-National Capital Region. The eastern region moderated amid fewer residential launches this year, while the western region eased a bit, with Mumbai and Pune office absorption balancing a softer residential pace.

During the year, developers showed caution amid elevated input costs and slower movement in mid to low-income housing. Non-developers including banks, financial institutions, and private

equity firms kept their outlook, signalling confidence backed by liquidity and asset quality.

In the residential segment, 71% of respondents of the survey expect launches to remain stable or rise, while 74% foresee sales staying steady or improving, a sharp rise from 52% in the second quarter.

Price expectations remain firm, with 92% anticipating stability or

an increase. NCR, Bengaluru, and Hyderabad registered 13-19% on-year price gains in the September quarter.

The office segment remained the most optimistic, with 78% expecting stable or rising new supply, and 95% anticipating rents to remain stable or rise amid tight Grade A availability and rising pre-commitments.



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Realty sentiment up despite many headwinds: Naredco

Confidence among stakeholders is improving in the third quarter (calendar 2025), according to the National Real Estate Development Council (Naredco).

The 46th edition of the Knight Frank-Naredco Real Estate Sentiment Index Q3 2025 (July-September) said the 'Current Sentiment Score' has gone up to 59 in the third quarter that ended September 30, up from 56 in the previous quarter.

"This reflects its resilience amid a challenging global economic environment. The index reflects strengthening market fundamentals driven by robust office leasing activity, resilient residential demand, especially in high-ticket segments, and sup-

portive macro-economic conditions," said Naredco President Parveen Jain.

"Liquidity has remained healthy, inflation has eased and policy consistency has reinforced confidence among developers and investors alike," he said.

"Developers and investors remain optimistic, supported by stable demand, policy continuity and healthy funding conditions. Premium housing and office spaces drive growth, signalling a balanced, resilient outlook for the sector," he added.

SOUTH ZONE LEADS

Driven by strong leasing momentum in Bengaluru and Hyderabad, the South Zone leads in the indices. The North Zone maintained its recovery, while the West Zone dipped marginally from 61 to 59.

रियल एस्टेट परियोजनाओं को राहत

उच्चतम न्यायालय द्वारा पर्यावरण संबंधी मंजूरी पर मई 2025 में दिया गया अपना निर्णय वापस लिए जाने के बाद सैकड़ों रियल एस्टेट परियोजनाओं पर मंडरा रहा खतरा टल गया है। विशेषज्ञों के अनुसार इससे घर खरीदारों, विनिर्माताओं (डेवलपर) और ऋणदाताओं को बड़ी राहत मिली है।

शीर्ष न्यायालय के नवीनतम फैसले से पर्यावरण संबंधी मंजूरी हासिल करने में प्रक्रियात्मक चूक के कारण कई परियोजनाओं को राहत मिली है। अब परियोजनाएं रोकने के बजाय उचित पर्यावरणीय आकलन से गुजरना पड़ सकता है।

एनार्क ग्रुप के अध्यक्ष अनुज पुरी के अनुसार मुंबई महानगर क्षेत्र (एमएमआर) और पुणे में फंसी 490 से ज्यादा परियोजनाएं अब नियमित होने के लिए पात्र हो गई हैं। इन परियोजनाओं 70,000 से अधिक आवासीय इकाइयां हैं। लगभग 30,000 करोड़ रुपये लागत वाली इन परियोजनाओं पर तत्काल बंद होने का खतरा दूर हो गया है।

रियल एस्टेट उद्योग से जुड़े लोगों का कहना है कि इस फैसले से उन परियोजनाओं के लिए रास्ता खुल गया है जो कानूनी अनिश्चितता से जूझ रही थीं।



राष्ट्रीय रियल एस्टेट विकास परिषद (नारेडको) के अध्यक्ष प्रवीण जैन ने कहा कि इस निर्णय से आवास की उपलब्धता में बाधा दूर हो जाएगी और निवेश से जुड़े जोखिम भी दूर हो गए हैं। जैन ने कहा कि इसके साथ ही रुकी हुई निर्माण परियोजनाओं के कारण रोजगार को हो रहा नुकसान भी अब नहीं होगा।

नारेडको के चेयरपर्सन डॉ. निरंजन हीरानंदानी ने कहा कि उच्चतम न्यायालय द्वारा पर्यावरणीय मंजूरी पर पूर्व में लगाए प्रतिबंध वापस लिए जाने से रियल एस्टेट उद्योग को काफी राहत मिली है। उन्होंने कहा, 'गिराए जाने के खतरे का सामना कर रही कई परियोजनाएं अब अचानक बंद होने के बजाय विस्तृत पर्यावरणीय समीक्षा से गुजर सकती हैं।'

उच्चतम न्यायालय ने 18 नवंबर को 2 बनाम 1 के बहुमत से अपने मई 2025 का

निर्णय वापस ले लिया। इस पुनर्विचार याचिका के साथ पहले के प्रतिबंध फिलहाल हटा दिए गए हैं और मामले पर नए सिरे से विचार करने के लिए एक उपयुक्त पीठ के समक्ष रखा गया है। अब गिराए जाने का सामना कर रही परियोजनाएं बंद होने के बजाय उचित जांच-पड़ताल से गुजर सकती हैं। जैन ने कहा, 'इस कदम से डेवलपर, ऋणदाताओं और घर खरीदारों के लिए अल्पकालिक स्थिरता बहाल होती है जो अनिश्चितता से जूझ रहे थे। यह निर्णय परियोजनाओं को उचित पर्यावरणीय आकलन के माध्यम से अनुपालन प्रदर्शित करने के लिए समय भी देता है।'

हालांकि, दिल्ली स्थित एक डेवलपर ने कहा कि यह एक व्यापक अनुमति तो नहीं है क्योंकि मामले को केवल एक उपयुक्त पीठ के पास भेजा गया है। उन्होंने कहा, 'डेवलपर को अभी भी पर्यावरणीय व्यवहार्यता को सही ठहराने और अपने दस्तावेजीकरण और जोखिम-प्रबंधन प्रथाओं को मजबूत करने की जरूरत होगी।' प्रोपर्टी कंसल्टेंसी के मुख्य कार्याधिकारी मोहित मित्तल ने भी कहा कि यह निर्णय एक झटके में तो सारी समस्याएं हल नहीं करता है लेकिन यह कम से कम डेवलपर को अचानक स्थगन आदेश या गिराए जाने बारे में चिंता करने के बजाय अपनी पर्यावरणीय जांच ठीक से करवाने के लिए एक सीधा रास्ता देता है।

Young Game Changers of Indian Realty 2025 concludes with dynamic panels, inspiring keynotes, and felicitations celebrating the sector's rising leaders.

The Young Game Changers of Indian Realty 2025 event, hosted by Outlook at The Lalit, New Delhi, brought together dynamic leaders shaping the future of Indian real estate. SC's green clearance ruling recall could push ahead stalled projects

Move to give relief to thousands of homebuyers and developers

The Supreme Court's recall of its May ruling on ex-post facto environmental clearances has eased the immediate threat of demolition of hundreds of real-estate projects, offering relief to homebuyers, developers, and lenders, say experts.

Several ongoing developments were facing the threat due to procedural lapses in securing environmental approvals. Projects can now undergo a proper environmental assessment rather than be halted.

According to Anuj Puri, chairperson, Anarock Group, over 490 projects stuck in limbo, impacting more than 70,000 housing units across the Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR) and Pune, are now eligible for regularisation.

These projects, collectively worth close to ₹30,000 crore, would no longer face an immediate shutdown.

Industry leaders say the judgment restores a measure of predictability for businesses, which were grappling with legal uncertainties.

Parveen Jain, president, National Real Estate Development Council (Naredco), said that the decision prevented a large-scale disruption to housing supply, protected ongoing investment, and avoided job losses linked to stalled construction.

Naredco Chairperson Niranjana Hiranandani added the court's decision gave a much-needed relief to real estate.

"Several projects that were at risk of demolition can now undergo a detailed environmental review, rather than face abrupt closures," he said.

On November 18, the Supreme Court, by a 2:1 majority, recalled its May judgment, which had prohibited the grant of ex-post facto (retrospective) environmental clearances. With this recall, the

earlier restrictions have been lifted for now, and the matter has been placed before an appropriate Bench for fresh consideration. Projects that were facing demolition can now an assessment instead of being shut down.

"The move restores short-term stability for developers, lenders, and homebuyers. It also buys time for projects to demonstrate compliance through proper environmental assessments," Jain said.

However, a Delhi-based developer said this was not blanket approval because the matter had been reopened for fresh examination by an appropriate Bench.

"Developers will still need to justify environmental viability and strengthen their documentation and risk-manage-

ment practices," he added.

Mohit Mittal, chief executive officer (CEO), MORES, a proptech consultancy, stated that while the new turn did not solve everything overnight, it gave developers a straightforward route to get their environmental checks done properly instead of worrying about sudden stay orders or the threat of demolition.

Legal specialists stressed the broader economic implications.

Samit Shukla, partner, dispute resolution practice, Trilegal, noted: "This acknowledges the environmental degradation that would arise if the judgment under review was not interfered with. Such a pragmatic approach was necessary to safeguard public resources and establishments contributing to the country's economy."

Abhilash Pillai, partner at legal firm Cyril Amarchand Mangaldas, said it signalled that the demolition-first approach would not return.

However, the relief is not absolute.

Shahid Balwa, vice-chairperson and managing director, Valor Estate, said retrospective approvals remained conditional.

"The majority opinion permits retrospective clearances only for activities permitted under current environmental rules, subject to penalties and safeguards. Developers should view this as an opportunity to strengthen ESG (environment, social, government) practices and ensure upfront approvals."

Arpit Jain, director at Arkade Developers, said: "We need a predictable and consistent regime that enforces compliance upfront and reduces the scope for ambiguity. The hope is that the larger Bench will now arrive at a position that upholds environmental safeguards while acknowledging the practical realities."



GIFT City on fast track after bid for 2030 CWG

GANDHINAGAR: Ahmedabad's successful bid for the 2030 Commonwealth Games last week has renewed attention on GIFT (Gujarat International Finance Tec) City, a central business district in Gujarat's Gandhinagar district.

The idea to build an international financial centre on a greenfield site was conceived in 2007 by the then Gujarat chief minister Narendra Modi. After initial years of slow growth and setbacks, the government converted GIFT into a fully state-owned company.

By 2011, the state had carved out a contiguous 3-sq-km (900-acre) plot along the Sabarmati and laid down the physical foundations—wide roads, a riverfront edge and perhaps the country's most advanced underground utility systems. The decisive shift came in 2020, when the Centre created the International Financial Services Centre Authority (IFSCA), a unified regulator for banking, insurance, funds, aircraft leasing and other offshore financial activity.

About 25 buildings are now operational and almost fully occupied, bringing roughly 27,000 people into the city every day. Another 37 towers are under construction. For now, GIFT remains primarily a workplace rather than a place where people live, but that is beginning to change. Around 930 homes have been delivered and over 7,000 are under construction.

Yogesh CBhavsar, president of the National Real Estate Development Council (Gujarat), said that with Ahmedabad's real estate market now nearly 60–70% saturated, the combination of upcoming global events, the growth of foreign university campuses, and steady organic urbanisation will accelerate GIFT City's next phase of expansion.

"The long-term target is to eventually accommodate a density of about 250,000 people per square kilometre, comparable to Navi Mumbai's," said Loveleen Garg, chief planner and vice president (Planning), GIFT City.

With the hard infrastructure set in place, GIFT is investing in public spaces to attract residents.

A 27-acre Central Park is under development along the extended riverfront. It will feature courts for soccer, box cricket, pickle ball and basketball, a golf driving range, jogging and cycling tracks, plazas, lawns and an amphitheatre. A dedicated food zone with restaurants and kiosks is also planned to draw workers and residents into shared spaces.

Hiran Shah, who runs Capital Russian Bakery in GIFT City, said the demand for retail spaces is now rising. "We see one or two new families moving in every day. Currently, the two occupied residential towers—Shobha and SJ Sangath—are around 30% full. Most of my customers are officegoers," he said. Shah travels 55 km daily to reach his bakery from Ahmedabad's Shilaj area.

Upendra Sagar, a State Bank of India employee who drives from Gandhinagar, said, "People mostly come in the morning and go back in the evening as there isn't much to stay back for yet".

He said the neighbourhood has "very few cafés" and there is hardly any street life. "Most of my colleagues are from outside Gujarat," Sagar said, adding that he isn't considering shifting to GIFT for now.

Officials say improved connectivity will transform GIFT into a bustling, compact city over the next few years. Two new metro stations have been sanctioned as part of the Ahmedabad-Gandhinagar line extension, and a direct road link to the airport is expected to bring travel time down to about ten minutes. GIFT

will also connect to the Sabarmati high-speed rail terminal, and once the Mumbai-Ahmedabad bullet train becomes operational, officials estimate that travel between GIFT and the Bandra-Kurla Complex could be about two hours and fifteen minutes.

What sets GIFT apart is its carefully engineered, below-ground infrastructure. Beneath the surface runs an underground utility tunnel—described by officials as the city's "nervous system"—carrying power cables, fibre, potable and recycled water, district cooling pipelines and automated waste ducts. About 5.5–5.7 km of the planned 16 km tunnel is complete. All repairs occur inside the tunnel, keeping the surface "completely digging-free," said Anil Parmar, Vice President (Engineering).

At its core, GIFT's IFSC is also taking shape as the offshore financial district it was envisioned to be. The zone now hosts 35 global banks and a rapidly expanding fund ecosystem with 320 investment funds managed by 97 fund managers.

"Entities operating out of the IFSC have raised more than \$58 billion for India so far," said K Rajaraman, chairman of the IFSCA and former Union finance secretary. The tax architecture—including a 10-out-of-15-year income-tax holiday—is "aligned with Singapore", he added.
